THE DE WILDT CHEETAH AND WILDLIFE CENTRE WAS ESTABLISHED BY ANN VAN DYK AND BROTHER GODFREY IN 1971 WITH THE AIM OF BREEDING ENDANGERED SPECIES.

SINCE THAT TIME, THE CENTRE'S EFFORTS HAVE RESULTED IN THE MAJOR ACHIEVEMENT OF BREEDING WHAT WAS ONCE A THREATENED SPECIES, THE CHEETAH (ACINONYX JUBATUS). OVER THE YEARS, OVER 750 CHEETAH CUBS HAVE BEEN BORN AT DE WILDT – A DRAMATIC CONTRAST TO THE DAYS WHEN THE CHEETAH POPULATION OF SOUTH AFRICA WAS ESTIMATED AT A MERE 700.

WHILE THE CHEETAH PROJECT WAS THE BASE FROM WHICH THE CENTER LAUNCHED ITS CONSERVATION ETHIC, IT SOON WIDENED TO INCLUDE OTHER RARE AND ENDANGERED ANIMALS SUCH AS WILD DOG, BROWN HYENA, SERVAL, SUNI ANTELOPE, BLUE AND RED DUIKER, BONTEBOK, RIVERINE RABBIT AND VULTURES INCLUDING THE VERY RARE EGYPTIAN VULTURE. MANY OF THESE HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY BRED FOR LATER REINTRODUCTION INTO THE WILD, THUS HELPING TO REPOPULATE AREAS WHERE SUCH SPECIES HAVE DISAPPEARED OR ARE NO LONGER ABUNDANT.

DURING 2000, AS A REACTION TO THE DECLINING NUMBERS OF CHEETAH IN THE WILD, DE WILDT SPEARHEADED THE INFORMATION OF THE NATIONAL CHEETAH MANAGEMENT FORUM (NCMF) WHICH DEVELOPED A NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR THE PROTECTION OF FREE-

ROAMING CHEETAH. ONE ACTION TO COME FROM THE GROUP WAS THE REALIZATION OF THE NEED FOR A NATIONAL CENSUS OF FREE-ROAMING CHEETAH. THIS CENSUS BEGUN IN 2003 AND CONTINUED FOR THREE YEARS.

THE COUNTRY OF SOUTH AFRICA HAS AWAKENED TO THE SUCCESS OF THE DE WILDT CHEETAH AND WILDLIFE TRUST. IN 2002, ITS FOUNDER AND DIRECTOR, ANN VAN DYK, RECEIVED THE GOLD MEDAL FROM THE WILDLIFE AND ENVIRONMENT SOCIETY; AND THAT WAS FOLLOWED IN 2003 BY ANN BEING AWARDED THE CHANCELLORS AWARD FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF PRETORIA. NESTLED IN THE FOOTHILLS OF THE MAGALIESBERG IN NORTH WEST PROVINCE, THE CENTRE IS SITUATED ABOUT ONE HOUR FROM JOHANNESBURG AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES FROM PRETORIA. IT IS CLOSE TO THE HARTBEESPOORT DAM, A POPULAR DESTINATION FOR DAY TRIPS FROM PRETORIA AND JOHANNESBURG. DURING 2009 THE CENTER WAS RENAMED THE ANN VAN DYK CHEETAH CENTRE. THIS IS AN EXCEPTIONALLY INTERESTING TOUR, PROVIDING THE VISITOR WITH UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN MORE ABOUT SOUTH AFRICA'S FASCINATING WILDLIFE – AND THE EFFORTS TO PRESERVE IT FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.

TACH – APARTHEID MUSEUM & CONSTITUTION HILL

DURATION: 5 HOURS AVAILABILITY: DAILY PICK-UP TIME: ANYTIME BETWEEN 08:00 AND 01:00PM MEALS: NOT INCLUDED ENTRANCE FEES: INCLUDED – GUIDED TOUR AT CONSTITUTION HILL, SELF-GUIDED TOUR AT APARTHEID MUSEUM



APARTHEID MUSEUM IN JOHANNESBURG IS REGARDED AS THE PRE-EMINENT MUSEUM IN THE WORLD DEALING WITH 20TH CENTURY SOUTH AFRICA, AT THE HEART OF WHICH IS THE STORY OF APARTHEID. THE MUSEUM OPENED ITS DOORS IN 2001 AND HERE VISITORS CAN EMBARK ON A HISTORICAL VOYAGE OF DISCOVERY, A PERSONAL EXPLORATION OF THE PAST THAT EXAMINES APARTHEID RIGHT UP TO THE FIRST DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS HELD IN 1994. THE TOUR OF THE MUSEUM, ACCOMPANIED BY THE GUIDE, LASTS FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO HOURS.

THE CONSTITUTION HILL PRECINCT IS BORDERED BY THE INNER-CITY NEIGHBORHOODS OF BRAAMFONTEIN AND HILLBROW. THIS IS WHERE THE SOUTH AFRICA'S NEW CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OPENED IN MARCH 2004. THE NEW COURT BUILDING IS, MOST APPROPRIATELY, ESTABLISHED ON THE SITE OF THE JOHANNESBURG FORT, BUILT AS A FORTRESS IN 1898 AND LATER CONVERTED INTO ONE OF THE COUNTRY'S MOST NOTORIOUS PRISON – POPULARLY KNOWN AS "NUMBER FOUR". THE FORT CLOSED ITS DOORS IN 1983. YOUR VISIT HERE INCLUDES THE MUSEUM THAT WAS ESTABLISHED IN THE OLD PRISON AND WILL BRING HOME THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THIS DEVELOPMENT AND WHAT IT MEANS FOR THE FUTURE OF JOHANNESBURG.

TASO – APARTHEID MUSEUM & SOWETO

DURATION: 5 HOURS AVAILABILITY: DAILY – EXCEPT ON CHRISTMAS DAY AND GOOD FRIDAY (SOME ATTRACTIONS MAY BE CLOSED ON PUBLIC HOLIDAYS) PICK-UP TIME: ANYTIME BETWEEN 08:00 AND 01:00PM MEALS: NOT INCLUDED ENTRANCE FEES: INCLUDED FOR APARTHEID MUSEUM ONLY PLEASE NOTE – NOT ALL ATTRACTIONS ON THIS TOUR ARE OPEN EVERY DAY.



THIS TOUR PROVIDES A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE A CLOSER LOOK AT SOUTH AFRICA'S TURBULENT PAST, BY COMBINING A DRIVE THROUGH SOWETO WITH A VISIT TO THE APARTHEID MUSEUM, REGARDED AS THE PREEMINENT MUSEUM IN THE WORLD DEALING WITH 20TH CENTURY SOUTH AFRICA, AT THE HEART OF WHICH IS THE STORY OF APARTHEID. THE MUSEUM OPENED ITS DOORS IN 2001 AND HERE VISITORS CAN EMBARK ON A HISTORICAL VOYAGE OF DISCOVERY, A PERSONAL EXPLORATION OF THE PAST THAT EXAMINES APARTHEID RIGHT UP TO THE FIRST DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS HELD IN 1994. THE TOUR OF THE MUSEUM, ACCOMPANIED BY THE GUIDE, LASTS FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO HOURS.

WE THEN CONTINUE TO SOWETO (SOUTH WESTERN TOWNSHIP), A SPRAWLING RESIDENTIAL AREA THAT HAS BECOME A "CITY WITHIN A CITY ". SOWETO IS HOME TO APPROXIMATELY 2-MILLION PEOPLE, MANY OF WHOM WORK IN VARIOUS PARTS OF THE GREATER JOHANNESBURG METROPOLITAN AREA.

YOUR GUIDE WILL FOLLOW A ROUTE THAT TAKES YOU PAST ALL THE MAJOR POINTS OF INTEREST, INCLUDING THE CHRIS HANI BARAGWANATH HOSPITAL, BARAGWANATH TAXI RANK, REGINA MUNDI CHURCH, HECTOR PIETERSON MEMORIAL AND NELSON MANDELA'S FORMER HOME.

TCOH – CRADLE OF HUMANKIND – MAROPENG & STERKFONTEIN

DURATION: 5 HOURS AVAILABILITY: DAILY PICK-UP TIME: 08:30AM OR 12:30PM MEALS: NOT INCLUDED ENTRANCE FEES: INCLUDED



GUIDED TOUR AT STERKFONTEIN, SELF-GUIDED OR GUIDED TOUR AT MAROPENG PLEASE NOTE: VISITORS TO STERKFONTEIN CAVES MUST PLEASE WEAR COMFORTABLE SHOES AND LEAVE HANDBAGS AND OTHER LUGGAGE BEHIND. THERE ARE A NUMBER OF TIGHT SPOTS AND PATHWAYS TO NEGOTIATE IN THE CAVES AND IT IS NOT ADVISABLE TO DO THE TOUR IF YOU ARE CLAUSTROPHOBIC. IT IS ALSO NOT ADVISABLE FOR VISITORS WHO SUFFER FROM ACUTE ASTHMA OR CHEST PROBLEMS TO DO THE TOUR, AS THE ENTRY AND EXIT REQUIRE CLIMBING UP AND DOWN STAIRWAYS.

THE STERKFONTEIN CAVES WERE DISCOVERED IN 1896 BY AN ITALIAN GOLD PROSPECTOR WHICH ARE NOW REGARDED AS ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST IMPORTANT ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES. THE CAVES LIE IN THE STERKFONTEIN VALLEY WHICH, TOGETHER WITH THE NEARBY SITES OF SWARTKRANS, DRIMOLEN AND KROMDRAAI, MAKE UP THE "CRADLE OF HUMANKIND" WORLD HERITAGE SITE. DR ROBERT BROOM OF THE TRANSVAAL MUSEUM (MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY) BEGAN EXCAVATIONS AT THE CAVE IN 1936 AND IN 1947 DISCOVERED A WELL-PRESERVED COMPLETE SKULL OF A SPECIES OF EARLY MAN KNOWN AS PLESIANTHROPUS TRANSVAALENSIS. THIS LATER BECAME KNOWN AS THE FAMOUS "MRS. PLES." YOUR TOUR WILL START AT THE NEWLY OPENED 260M2 EXHIBITION. THIS SCIENTIFIC EXHIBITION CONSISTS OF FOUR LARGE SHOW CASES WHICH INCLUDE LIFE LIKE MODELS OF HOMINIDS, A SABRE TOOTH CAT, A RECONSTRUCTION OF A MINED CAVE VS. A PRISTINE CAVE, CAVE FORMATIONS AND GEOLOGIES, EARLY LIFE FORMS, FOSSILS IN GENERAL (MAMMALS AND HOMO), SPECIFIC KINDS (LIKE MRS. PLES, TAUNG CHILD, LITTLE FOOT), DETAILS OF FOSSILIZATION, PALEO BOTANY AND LANDSCAPES. FROM THERE YOU WILL MAKE YOUR WAY UP THE LIMEKILNS, PAST THE SUNDIAL AND THEN UNDERGROUND INTO THE DEPTHS OF THE CAVES. BENEATH THE DUST OF MILLIONS OF YEARS YOU'LL SEE FOR YOURSELF THE RESTING PLACE OF SOME OF THE MOST IMPORTANT FOSSILS EVER FOUND, AND YOU'LL HEAR THE MAGNITUDE OF THEIR SIGNIFICANCE TO THE WORLD! AFTER PROCEEDING OVER THE WALKWAYS TO VIEW THE EXCAVATION WHICH WAS MRS. PLES'S FINAL RESTING PLACE, THE TRIP WILL CONTINUE PAST THE FOSSIL PREP

WHERE SCIENTISTS CONTINUE TO INVESTIGATE THE CLUES TO OUR PAST. ABOUT 10 KM AWAY FROM THE STERKFONTEIN CAVES LAYS THE WORLD CLASS VISITOR FACILITY OF MAROPENG, WHICH OPENED TO THE PUBLIC IN DECEMBER 2005. THE

FOCAL POINT IS THE TUMULUS BUILDING, DESIGNED TO LOOK LIKE AN ANCIENT BURIAL MOUND FROM THE FRONT. THE ARCHITECTURE IS SYMBOLIC OF THE JOURNEY THROUGH THE EVOLUTION OF LIFE THAT ARE PRESENTED IN THE VISITOR ATTRACTION AND UPON EXITING AFTER THE TOUR, ONE LOOKS BACK ON A VERY MODERN STRUCTURE. MAROPENG ALSO OFFERS RESTAURANTS AND A MARKETPLACE. THE TUMULUS CONTAINS A VAST UNDERGROUND VISITOR ATTRACTION WHICH TELLS THE STORY OF THE CRADLE OF HUMANKIND AND BRINGS TO LIFE THE HISTORY OF HUMANKIND IN ENTERTAINING, EDUCATIVE, AND INTERACTIVE WAYS. WITHIN THE VISITOR ATTRACTION LIES AN EXCITING 4-BILLION-YEAR JOURNEY ON AN UNDERGROUND LAKE, THROUGH THE ELEMENTAL FORCES - WATER, AIR, FIRE, AND EARTH - DIPPING THROUGH WATERFALLS AND REAL ICEBERGS, INTO THE EYE OF A STORM, PAST ERUPTING VOLCANOES AND THROUGH THE DEPTHS OF THE EARTH AND EMERGING AT THE BEGINNING OF THE WORLD. FROM HERE, THE JOURNEY CONTINUES THROUGH AN EXPERIENCE HIGHLIGHTING THE HISTORY OF OUR WORLD AND HUMANKIND AS SPECIES, BROUGHT TO LIFE VIA AUDIO-VISUAL TECHNIQUES, EVOCATIVE SOUND EFFECTS, THEME-PARK TECHNOLOGY, AND THEATRICAL DISPLAYS. THERE ARE ALSO REAL FOSSILS ON DISPLAY AT THE VISITOR CENTER. CHILDREN WILL DELIGHT IN THE INTERACTIVE ELEMENTS OF THE EXHIBITS, WHICH ENCOURAGE THEM TO EXPERIENCE RATHER THAN JUST OBSERVE OUR DEVELOPMENT AS A SPECIES AND THE UNDERLYING MESSAGE OF THE UNITY OF HUMANKIND.

YOUR VISIT TO THE CRADLE OF HUMANKIND WILL INCLUDE A GUIDED TOUR OF STERKFONTEIN. MAROPENG IS A SELF-GUIDED TOUR.

TCDM-S/U - CULLINAN DIAMOND MINE


SPECIAL NOTE: CHILDREN UNDER 10 YEARS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO JOIN THIS TOUR.

DIAMONDS WERE FIRST DISCOVERED IN ABOUT 1888 IN THE RIVER SYSTEMS EAST OF WHERE CULLINAN IS TODAY, A FASCINATING HISTORY BEGAN WHICH LED TO THE DISCOVERY OF PREMIER MINE (NOW CULLINAN DIAMOND MINE). THE MINE WAS DISCOVERED ON A FARM CALLED ELANDSFONTEIN, OWNED BY WILLEM PRINSLOO. THOMAS CULLINAN BOUGHT THE FARM AND SOON AFTER, IN 1902,

THE PREMIER DIAMOND MINING COMPANY WAS REGISTERED. PROSPECTING BEGAN WITHOUT DELAY AND MINING BEGAN THE FOLLOWING YEAR. IN 1905, ONE OF THE GREATEST EVENTS IN DIAMOND HISTORY TOOK PLACE WHEN AN ENORMOUS DIAMOND, WEIGHING 3106 CARATS, WAS FOUND. NAMED AFTER THOMAS CULLINAN AND REMAINS THE LARGEST DIAMOND EVER FOUND.

AFTER THE HORROR OF WORLD WAR 2 CAME TO AN END IN 1945 PREMIER WAS REOPENED BUT TOOK 10 MONTHS TO PUMP OUT AROUND FOUR BILLION LITERS OF WATER THAT HAD ACCUMULATED IN THE MINE'S 189M-DEEP PIT OVER ITS 14 DORMANT YEARS. AT THIS TIME PREMIER BEGAN ITS FORAY INTO UNDERGROUND MINING AND A PROSPEROUS NEW PERIOD HAD BEGUN.

IN 1977 THE PREMIER (TRANSVAAL) DIAMOND COMPANY WAS AMALGAMATED INTO DE BEERS CONSOLIDATED AND A BREATH OF FRESH AIR BLEW THROUGH THE MINE. MORE RECENTLY, IN JULY 2008, THE MINE WAS BOUGHT BY PETRA DIAMONDS IS STILL FULLY OPERATIONAL TODAY. CULLINAN IS ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST CELEBRATED DIAMOND MINES AND IS RENOWNED FOR PRODUCING MANY OF THE MOST SPECTACULAR DIAMONDS EVER SEEN, SUCH AS THE CULLINAN, PREMIER ROSE, NIARCHOS, THE CENTENARY AND THE GOLDEN JUBILEE.



TELS – ELEPHANT SANCTUARY – AM OR PM TOUR

IN THE EARLY 1900'S, THE MAGALIESBERG WERE RICH IN WILDLIFE AND HOME TO ABUNDANT ELEPHANTS. AS A RESULT OF PRESSURE BY MAN, THIS SENSITIVE ANIMAL DISAPPEARED FROM THE LANDSCAPE. ONE HUNDRED YEARS LATER THE ELEPHANTS HAVE RETURNED TO THIS AREA, TO A SPECIAL PLACE IN THE HEART OF THE BEAUTIFUL AFRICAN BUSHVELD.

NESTLED IN THE MAGALIESBERG MOUNTAINS ONLY ONE HOUR FROM JOHANNESBURG AND PRETORIA, THE ELEPHANT SANCTUARY LIES IN A MALARIA-FREE AREA, THE GREATER PART WITHIN THE MAGALIESBERG NATURE RESERVE. SURROUNDED BY NATURAL INDIGENOUS BUSH AND IS HOME TO IMPALA, KLIPSPRINGER, BABOONS, PORCUPINE, CARACAL, LEOPARD, A HOST OF OTHER SMALL MAMMALS, 350 BIRD SPECIES AND OF COURSE SIX MAGNIFICENT AFRICAN ELEPHANTS. YOUR VISIT WILL BRING YOU CLOSE TO THESE MAGNIFICENT ANIMALS, AN EXPERIENCE TO CHERISH AND REMEMBER FOREVER!

GUESTS ARE GUIDED IN SMALL GROUPS ON FOOT THROUGH THE ELEPHANT SANCTUARY. THE GUIDE WILL PROVIDE IN-DEPTH INFORMATION AND INSIGHT INTO AFRICAN ELEPHANTS. YOU WILL BE INTRODUCED TO THE ELEPHANTS IN THE MOUNTAIN AREA, UPHILL WALK APPROXIMATELY 200M, AND HERE YOU WILL BE ABLE TO TOUCH AND INTERACT WITH THE ELEPHANTS. YOU WILL SEE THE SPECIAL

RELATIONSHIP THAT ELEPHANT HANDLERS SHARE WITH THEIR ELEPHANTS AND BECOME A PART OF IT, SHORT WALK WITH THE ELEPHANT'S TRUCK IN-HAND. SEE WHERE THE ELEPHANT SLEEP AT NIGHT IN THEIR STABLES. FEED THE ELEPHANTS. ON SOME HOT DAYS YOU MAY EVEN SEE THE ELEPHANTS SWIMMING.

MORNING TOUR ONLY (TELS-1) AFTER THE HOUR, ENJOY LUNCH ON THE MAIN DECK OVERLOOKING THE ELEPHANTS.

"THE VOLCANO THAT GAVE BIRTH TO A GAME RESERVE" THE PILANESBERG NATIONAL PARK LIES 160KM (100 MILES) FROM JOHANNESBURG IN THE BOJANALA REGION OF NORTH WEST – THE "PLATINUM PROVINCE" – AND IS THE FOURTH LARGEST NATIONAL PARK IN SOUTH AFRICA, COVERING AN AREA OF SOME 57 000 HECTARES. THE CRATER OF A LONG EXTINCT VOLCANO IS THE SETTING OF PILANESBERG NATIONAL PARK – A FASCINATING ALKALINE COMPLEX PRODUCED BY VOLCANIC ERUPTIONS SOME 1300 MILLION YEARS AGO. PILANESBERG IS ONE OF THE LARGEST VOLCANIC COMPLEXES OF ITS KIND IN THE WORLD AND HAS SURVIVED AGES OF EROSION AND STANDS HIGH ABOVE THE SURROUNDING BUSHVELD PLAINS.

THE EARLY PRESENCE OF MAN CAN BE SEEN IN THE NUMEROUS STONE AND IRON AGE SITES THAT ARE SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE PARK. ITS RARE ROCK TYPES AND STRUCTURE MAKE IT A UNIQUE GEOLOGICAL FEATURE AND THE TOPOGRAPHY MAKES THE AREA A FEAST FOR THE EYE. HERE ARE SYENITE KOPPIES, THICKLY FORESTED RAVINES, TYPICAL BUSHVELD AND ROLLING GRASSLANDS AND LIGHTLY WOODED AREAS. OFF THE CENTER OF THE PARK IS THABAYADIOTSO, "THE PROUD MOUNTAIN. THE BEAUTY OF PILANESBERG IS REFLECTED IN A LARGE CENTRAL LAKE, THE MANKWE DAM.

THE PARK WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1979 AND GAME WAS REINTRODUCED; THANKS TO OPERATION GENESIS, WHICH AT THE TIME WAS THE LARGEST GAME TRANSLOCATION EVER UNDERTAKEN ANYWHERE. THE PARK OFFERS THE VISITOR A WIDE DIVERSITY OF 35 ANIMAL SPECIES, INCLUDING THE "BIG FIVE", 350 BIRD SPECIES AND 65 REPTILE SPECIES – ALL IN A MALARIA FREE AREA.

WE ENTER THE PARK AT MANYANE GATE IN THE EAST AND MAKE OUR WAY WESTWARDS, EVENTUALLY REACHING OUR LUNCH STOP AT BAKUBUNG – "PEOPLE OF THE HIPPO." THE AFTERNOON IS SPENT IN SEARCH OF MORE GAMES AS WE MAKE OUR WAY BACK TO MANYANE GATE, STOPPING AT ONE OF THE GAME VIEWING HIDES EN ROUTE. WE RETURN TO JOHANNESBURG IN THE AFTERNOON.

THE CITY OF PRETORIA LIES ONLY 58 KM (36 MILES) NORTH OF JOHANNESBURG AND PROVIDES A COMPLETE CONTRAST TO THE CITY OF GOLD.

SOUTH AFRICA'S ADMINISTRATIVE CAPITAL WAS FOUNDED IN 1855 AND NAMED AFTER THE VOORTREKKER LEADER, ANDRIES PRETORIOUS. OFTEN REFERRED TO AS "JACARANDA CITY," THIS NICKNAME REFERS TO THE THOUSANDS OF TREES LINING THE STREETS, THEIR PURPLE BLOSSOMS HERALDING THE APPROACH OF SUMMER EACH OCTOBER.

OUR TOUR BEGINS WITH A VISIT TO THE VOORTREKKER MONUMENT, A STRIKING MEMORIAL BUILT TO HONOR THE EARLY PIONEERS. WE THEN CONTINUE TO THE CENTRAL PART OF THE CITY WHICH HAS RETAINED THE NAME PRETORIA, VISITING KRUGER HOUSE MUSEUM AND CHURCH SQUARE, WHERE THE STATUE OF PAUL KRUGER LOOKS DOWN ON THE PEOPLE PASSING BY. MELROSE HOUSE IS A CLASSIC EXAMPLE OF VICTORIAN SUBURBAN TOWNHOUSE, AND A VISIT CAN ALSO BE INCLUDED, SUBJECT TO TIME PERMITTING (CLOSED ON MONDAYS!). WE THEN CONTINUE TO THE IMPOSING UNION BUILDINGS, WHICH HOUSES THE OFFICES OF THE STATE PRESIDENT, DEPUTY PRESIDENT AND MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS. OUR STOP HERE PROVIDES AN IMPRESSIVE VIEW OVER THE CITY AND COMPLETES THE TOUR, BEFORE RETURNING TO YOUR HOTEL.
